Nursing Homes

As Ernie performed for his beloved mother-in-law in her final days in a nursing home, he began to develop a program that would be most effective with an elderly audience. They love to nod, hum and clap to the old jazz standards and hymns. They have a love for this timeless, deep music and often come up to Ernie expressing gratitude that he is keeping this music alive.

Hospitals

Both the preemie unit and chemo unit of a Pittsburgh hospital play Ernie's CD "Bluesified". They feel this music is particularly healing. One cancer patient traveled alone, many miles on a winter night to hear Ernie in a concert. She said she just had to meet the person who played the music during her chemotherapy treatments.
